


Fatalities and Safety Violations on New York Construction Sites

Top 4 Causes of Construction/Extraction Industry Fatalities in New York (2012)ⁱⁱ

- 57%: Slips, trips, and falls
- 14%: Contact with objects and equipment
- 12%: Exposure to harmful substances or environments
- 12%: Transportation incidents



OSHA: The Occupational Safety and Health Administration is a federal agency meant to "assure safe and healthful working conditions for working men and women" in the U.S.!

The Top 7 OSHA Standards Violations for the 2013 Fiscal Yearⁱ

1. Fall protection
2. Hazard communication standard
3. Scaffolding
4. Respiratory protection
5. Electrical, wiring methods, components, and equipment
6. Powered industrial trucks
7. Ladders



The construction industry accounts for approximately 50% of fall-related deaths and injuries.ⁱⁱⁱ
